PARKING & KING JOHN'S ROAD

HOME ALONE

There is no legal age at which children may be left home alone, but they must not be left at risk of injury or suffering. The NSPCC gives useful tips to help parents decide in what situations they may leave their children home alone, and to do to ensure their child's safety and wellbeing.

We have used these tips to draft an 'Emergency Plan', which you could use as a basis for discussion with your children, and to fill in and keep at home. Online copies are attached, and paper copies are available from the office. Even if they are too young or you never leave your children alone, for any reason, it is still useful to talk about these things in terms they understand, just in case of an emergency or accident to you.

SAFEGUARDING

Safeguarding children is about more than spotting obvious signs of child abuse and child protection. It is also about keeping children safe and healthy, and providing for their social, emotional and developmental needs. We are all involved in this together, and it is what we all do every day when looking after children at home, in the village, at school and at playgroup. We will discuss concerns and worries with you, and we hope that you feel able to do the same with us. We will take action and seek further advice where we think it is important for the welfare and protection of any child.
